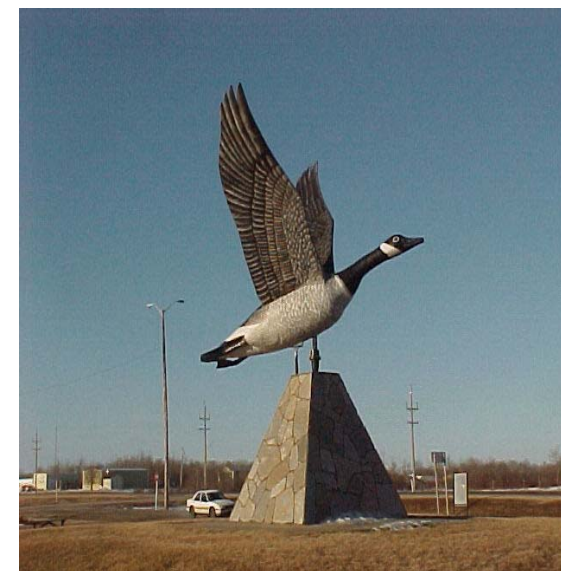

**Giant Canada Goose Monument** *Lundar* Located on the East side of PTH #6.

### Lundar Farmer's Market

### Lundar Wildlife Management Area
