BY-LAW NO. 03/21 RURAL MUNICIPALITY(RM) OF COLDWELL SPECIAL SERVICE PLAN NO. 2021-01

To provide for the collections and transportation of waste and recyclable material for the RM of Coldwell

Pursuant to section 315 of The Municipal Act

A. Proposed Special Service:

The Rural Municipality of Coldwell is proposing to provide a Special Service levy for the pickup of garbage and recycling from Residential, Commercial and Institutional property in the RM of Coldwell as a special service. In 2008 Council proposed and passed By-Law 03/07 which moved the recovery for these services from the general municipal levy (at large) to a specific amount per each parcel of land. By-law 03/18expired at the end of 2020 and Council is proposing to continue this service and special service tax, the rates have increased slightly.

B. Area of Municipality for Special Service:

The Council of the RM of Coldwell intends to impose this Special Service tax on all benefitting property (ie .all taxable, grant-in-lieu, otherwise exempt) in the RM including the LUD of Lundar. Class 30(Farmland) is excluded as well as vacant lots.

C. Estimated Cost of Service:

In 2020 the actual cost was \$163,600.00.

The estimated costs for the years 2021 to 2023 are:

2021 \$174,580.00

2022 \$178,640.00

2023 \$186,760.00

D. Method and Rate of Calculating Special Service Tax

The method of taxation to be used to calculate the Special Service Tax will be on a per parcel basis. All parcels are allowed 2 bags of garbage per week and must have recycling to have a pick up .If one should accumulate extra waste over the week , extra garbage tickets may be purchased at the Municipal Office for \$3.00/bag. Commercial and Institutional properties will arrange for excess waste removal by a private contractor if required.

RURAL MUNICIPALITY(RM) OF COLDWELL BY-LAW NO. 03/21

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RM OF COLDWELL TO ESTABLISH A RATE FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND RECYCLING PICKUP AS A SPECIAL SERVICE IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF COLDWELL, INCLUDING THE LUD OF LUNDAR FOR 2021-2023.

WHEREAS Section 312 of The Municipal Act of Manitoba, provides in part as follows:

- 312 If approved by by-law, a municipality may provide, as a special service to all or part of a municipality, one of more of the following:
 - (e) the collection and transportation of waste or recyclable materials;

AND WHEREAS subsection 320(1) of the Act provides as follows:

- 320(1) Subject to subsections (2) to (6) and subsection 321(4), a council may by by-law
 - (a) approve the local improvement or special services as set out in the plan or proposal;
 and
 - (b) authorize the municipality to impose taxes as set out in the plan or proposal.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the RM OF COLDWELL has prepared Special Services Plan No. 2021-01 to establish a rate for the collection of garbage and recycling as a special service pursuant to Part 10 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS the requirements as prescribed in section 318, 319, and 320 of the Act have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the RM of Coldwell, in open council assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. That pursuant to subsection 320(1) of the Act, the RM of Coldwell approves Special Service Plan No.2021-01 attached hereto as Schedule "A".
- 2. That the RM of Coldwell levy an annual special service tax upon all rateable properties within the municipality as hereby attached in Schedule "B".
